CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. H. Gibson, Secretary has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and pipelines for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 28 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 3 bears N. 46° 00' E., 2,040 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 29, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a pipeline to the place of use located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T. 28 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B. & M., and there used for mining and milling purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
