CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bill DeLong has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Strebar Springs through 2" pipe and concrete trough for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 36 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Section 5 bears N. 64° 02' W., 931.5 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. Lynn Roberts
Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.218 c.f.s., or enough to water 700 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 2, 1954

Description of manner and place of use:
Water is developed from Strebar Spring and conveyed by pipeline to a concrete trough located in the same subdivision where it is used for stockwatering and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
