CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. O. Larson, Regional Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from The Humboldt River through dam, canals and ditches for irrigation, domestic and stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Rye Patch Dam, through Young, Old Channel, Union, Irish American, Rodgers, Big Five, Sommers Seventeen Canals, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
