CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Trail Creek through headgate, flume and ditches for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., bears N. 55° 27' E., 10,347 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 14, 1946

Description of manner and place of use:
The water is diverted from Trail Creek by a diversion flume and conveyed by pipeline to the place of use within NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., and NW 1/4 Section 6, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., and there used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Application No. 11486, Certificate No. 2990, hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Application No. 11486, Certificate No. 2990.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
