CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bertrand Arambel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from North Indian Spring through spring, concrete box, pipelines and reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 18 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of Sec. 12, T. 18 N., R. 59 E., bears S. 83° 59' E., 13,809 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bertrand Arambel
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0046 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle
Period of use, from: June 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 15, 1952

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed from North Indian Spring, conveyed by pipeline to an earthen reservoir located in the E 1/2 of SW 1/4 of Section 10, T. 18 N., R. 59 E., where it is used for stockwatering purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
