

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, V. W. Smith, Superintendent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipelines for railroad and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 34 bears S. 0° 40' 21" W., 3,588.35 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation..... 0.736 c.f.s., or not to exceed 67.0 m.g. annually
Period of use, from..... January 1st..... to..... December 31st..... of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation..... August 23, 1924.....

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the places of use located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34 and E 1/2 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion under Application No. 7200, Certificate No. 1631, hence the priority of this certificate is the same as Application No. 7200, Certificate 1631.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
