CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles W. Ross has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 21 bears S. 32° 24' 48" E., 2,350 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

3.7 acres in Portion W 1/2 W 1/2 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
