CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Calvin B. Wilds and Bealle M. Wilds has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and sprinkler system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 6 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Section 33 bears N. 89° 54' W., 1,358.4 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

40 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 6 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
