CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary Louise Darling has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from The Carson River (flood and surplus) through Mexican Dam and ditch for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 35 bears N. 12° 30' E. 3,075 feet situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

An undetermined portion of the irrigated lands and appurtenant water rights under this certificate are subject to the final decree now pending in Case No. D-183 in the U. S. District Court in and for the District of Nevada, in the matter of U. S. of America, Plaintiff, vs. Alpine Land and Reservoir Company, a corporation, Defendant.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
