CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James D. Wallace, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from East Fork Carson River (Hogrefe or Rocky Slough) through dam and Nelson Ditch or Dick Tholke Ditch for stockwatering, irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 58° 06' W., 4,148 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

3 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

* This certificate is issued to change the point of diversion of the waters of East Fork Carson River (Hogrefe or Rocky Slough) as set forth in the Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Decree, as amended, entered by the U. S. District Court of Nevada, Case No. D-183, U. S. of America, Plaintiff vs. Alpine Land and Reservoir Co., a corporation, et al., Defendants, and is subject to the terms and conditions of the Final Decree, when entered.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
