CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. T. Cureton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Thorne Spring (Saline Spring) through open cut, pipeline and tank for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 21 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 40° 10' W., 2,961.32 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: L. T. Cureton
Post-office address: Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 19 cows or horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 11, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an open cut in the spring and flows through a pipeline to the place of use located within the same sub-division as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
