CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vera Krupp has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mule Spring through box, pipeline and tanks for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of Sec. 28, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., bears S. 31° 05' W., 11,110 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0033 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle
Period of use, from May 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 20, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a wooden box and conveyed by means of a pipeline to tanks located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., and the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 23 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
