CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Peter Damele has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, ditches and reservoirs for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 19 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 5 bears N. 79° 30' E., 410 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 5.0 c.f.s., or not to exceed 1,110.64 feet annually

Period of use, from April 15th to October 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 1, 1951

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
