CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry Marks has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe system through pump, pipeline and distribution for domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) Sec. 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears S. 79° 53' 18" E., 843.26 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Glenbrook, Nevada

* Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s., not to exceed 1,440 gallons per day

* Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 5, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is pumped from Lake Tahoe through a distribution system to the place of use, located in portions of Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) Sec. 10 and Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) Sec. 15, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

* Note: It is understood that in addition to the summer use, as designated, the appropriator will be entitled to intermittent use during the non-summer season, on the basis of not to exceed fifty gallons per capita per day.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
