CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William O. Bradley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring No. 2 through pipe, troughs and tanks for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 29 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 48° 55' 35" W., 4,197.4 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1000 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 2, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an excavation and piped to troughs and tanks within the same subdivision as is the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
