CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. O. Wright, Assistant Highway Engineer, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and pipelines for domestic (Highway Maintenance Station and public service) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Sec. 25, T. 32 N., R. 59 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 25 bears N. 85° 22' 49" W., 2,555.10 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: State of Nevada, Dept. of Highways
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 21, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, and is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located within the same subdivision as is the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
