CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert S. Leighton, Water Resources Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River system through dam, ditch, reservoir & distribution for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 75° 16' E. 1,650 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 5.75 c.f.s., or 493.65 ac. ft. per year  
Period of use, from as decreed of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation January 29, 1865

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is conveyed from the Truckee River to the Highland Reservoir by means of the Highland Ditch and is conveyed to the cities of Reno and Sparks and contiguous areas, through a distribution system.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of water under Claims 526 and 527, Truckee River Final Decree, Docket A-3 in the District Court of the United States of America, in and for the District of Nevada.

Note: This water is changed from the North Truckee Ditch to the Highland Ditch.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
