CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Anna Barozzi has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring (A) through collection box, pipeline & trucks for mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 29° 13' 04" W., 1,702.13 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 11, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of French drains, made of 6 in. V.C.P., 100 ft. long, encased in gravel to collect spring seepages; thence piped to junction box for truck loading. The water is then trucked to tunnel in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
