CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert H. Barnett, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Truckee River

through dam and Orr Ditch for

irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 17 bears N. 78° 36' W., 2,260 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 7 ac. ft. annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation Year 1863

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

2 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the place of use of Application No. 11014, Certificate No. 2824; hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Application No. 11014, Certificate No. 2824.

Note: Certificate No. 2824 changed point of diversion of water from Hayder or Court Ditch to Orr Ditch and also place of use of water both under Claim No. 372 of the Truckee River Decree. In the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada, in Equity, Docket A3.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
