CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph Terrible has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for domestic (two dwellings) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 27 bears S. 68° 15' 30" E., 886.4 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joseph Terrible
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., not to exceed 2,880 gallons per day
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 20, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, and is pumped through a distribution system to the places of use located within the E 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., and there to be used in two homes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
