CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert J. Agee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Salmon River through dam, headgates and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 45 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of Sec. 17, T. 45 N., R. 62 E., bears N. 51° 27' E., 5,834 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.0 c.f.s., not to exceed 196.6 ac. ft. per season
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 15, 1954

This certificate is issued to conform with the Salmon River Settlement Agreement, dated May 20, 1952.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
