CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Pahrump Artesian Basin) through well, pump, pipelines & ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 88° 31' E., 2,709.00 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.0 c.f.s., not to exceed 150 ac. ft. per season

Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 4, 1946

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

30 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 21, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
