CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Verne L. Despain, Acting Assistant Regional Forester has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring in Union Canyon through catch basin, pipe and trough for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 12 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 5, T. 11 N., R. 39 E., bears S. 44° 28' W. 15,147 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a metal catch basin; hence it is conveyed by pipe southwesterly to a metal trough located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 22, T. 12 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
