CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed channel and tributaries (irrigation waste water-Truckee River) through reservoir for wildlife management (hunting and fishing) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 20 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 15 bears N. 22° 24' W., 1,863.93 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Nevada Fish and Game Commission
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 910 acre feet storage annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 19, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded by dam in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 12, T. 20 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., with two outlet structures and spillway. Place of use is in reservoir in portions of Section 11 and W 1/2 Section 12, T. 20 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
