

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest H. Clary, City Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 24 bears N. 40° 46' W., 2,569 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.5 c.f.s., or not to exceed 5.0 m.g. annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 22, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the East Vegas Tract located within the SE 1/4 Sec. 13 and NE 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

* The place of use under this certificate is also served by Permit No. 13329 and the total diversion from both sources shall not exceed 12.5 m.g. annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
