CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. E. McKinney has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for commercial (service station) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Sec. 29 bears N. 66° 30' W., 2,410 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Richfield Oil Corporation
Post-office address: Los Angeles 5, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., or not to exceed 0.3 m.g. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 19, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located within a portion of E 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
