

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leo L. Laythe, Regional Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Porecupine Spring through earth catch basin for wildlife watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 44 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 41° 33' E., 2,347 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U. S. Fish & Wildlife Service, Bureau of Sport Fisheries & Wildlife
Post-office address: Portland, Oregon
Amount of appropriation: 0.004 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 10, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by cleaning out seepages and is held in an earth catch basin located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
