CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed channel and tributaries (irrigation waste water-Truckee River) through earth fill dam for wildlife management purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 20 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 12 bears N. 60° 33' 45" W., 1,127.48 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 476 acre feet storage annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 11, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded in a reservoir with an area of 95 acres and a capacity of 476 acre feet located in portions of Sections 1 and 12, T. 20 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for wildlife management.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
