CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert Delmua has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through windmill pump, auxiliary motor and reservoir stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 1 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Sec. 17, T. 1 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 67° 07' E., 14,502 ft. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 26, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped into a storage reservoir located within a portion of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 1 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
