

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leo L. Laythe, Regional Director, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pat Hurd Spring through pipe, open channel and catch basin for wildlife and stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) Sec. 2, T. 43 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 2 bears N. 87° 45' W., 560.0 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U. S. Fish & Wildlife Service, Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife
Post-office address: Portland 8, Oregon
Amount of appropriation: 0.0008 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 10, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water from a developed spring is conveyed in a southerly direction through 6 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe into an open ditch thence 40 feet to an earthen catch basin. Place of use is located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
