CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Horace E. Smith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Creek through dam and ditch for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 45 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Sec. 36 bears N. 23° 48' E., 1,759 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 10.0 c.f.s., and not to exceed 1,195.36 ac.ft. per season
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 10 columns: Acres, NE 1/4, NW 1/4, Section, T., R., M.D.B.&M. Rows list land parcels with acreage and section details, ending with a total of 298.84 acres.

This certificate is issued to conform with the Salmon River Settlement Agreement dated May 20, 1952.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
