CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John E. Bawden, Deputy State Highway Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 39 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 3 bears S. 63° 32' 40" W., 2,799.85 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: State of Nevada, Department of Highways
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.062 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 17, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located within a portion of SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 39 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to serve two homes and a maintenance shop.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
