CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. B. Gant has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, tank, pond and truck for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 11 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 2 bears N. 12° 31' W., 1,618.7 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 1, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and flows into a tank and pond from which it is pumped into a tank truck and hauled to the place of use located in the W 1/4 SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T. 11 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for mining, core drilling and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
