CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Karl W. Berg has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Healy's Spring (in Jefferson Canyon) through dam, pipeline, storage tanks and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 10 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Sec. 31, T. 11 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 53° 57' W., 24,387.93 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Round Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.125 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 22, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is impounded in a dam and conveyed by pipeline to storage tanks and thence conveyed through a distribution system to the place of use located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 19; and NE 1/4 NW 1/4, S 1/4 NW 1/4, N 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, W 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, T. 10 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed) where it is used to serve the Town of Round Mountain, Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
