CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William B. Wright has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 5) through well, windmill, tank and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 41 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Sec. 24, T. 41 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 47° 49' E., 21,513 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator William B. Wright

Post-office address Deeth, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 19, 1959

Description of works of diversion and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped by windmill to a circular trough and overflow to an earthen tank located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
