WHEREAS, Lt. Colonel, Base Engineer has presented to the State Engineer
of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)
through well, pump and distribution system for
quasi-municipal
purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 20 S.,
R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said
Sec. 3 bears N. 29° 02' W., 605 feet.
situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date,
source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 10, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 1,497 feet deep and
cased with 16 inch casing. It is equipped with a deep well pump
and a distribution system that conveys water to portions of Sections
3, 4, 9 and 10, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the
amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
