CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. D. Shields, district manager, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 51° 14' E., 934 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: California-Pacific Utilities Company
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.33 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 27, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped into a distribution system which conveys it to Sections 19 and 20, W 1/2 W 1/2 Section 28, Sections 29 and 30, N 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 32, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for municipal purposes in the City of Winnemucca, Nevada and contiguous area.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
