CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John C. Raymer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and pipelines for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 27 bears S. 30° 40' W., 500 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John C. Raymer
Post-office address 2900 Geiger Grade Rd., Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0022 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,440 gals. per day
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 10, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from a drilled well and conveyed by pipes to dwelling and yard where it is used for domestic purposes. The place of use is in a portion of the W 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 27, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
