CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, retail sales superintendent has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)

through well, pump and distribution system for

commercial (service station) and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 20,

T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner

of said Sec. 20 bears S. 16° 29' 32" E., 1,432.08 feet

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alan and Ruth L. Post

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.4 m.g. annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 9, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to a service station located within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
