CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. E. Tyson, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through wells, pumps and distribution system for air-conditioning (heating and cooling) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: N 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 57° 35' E., 1,173.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 16, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located in the N 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for heating and cooling and then returned to the same aquifer by means of drilled return well.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
