CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Trail Creek through diversion dam, settling pond, flume and pipeline for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 6, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 55° 27' E. 10,347 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by a dam through a settling pond, flume and pipeline to the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed) where it is used in the condensing system of a quicksilver reduction plant and in mining camp operations.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
