CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, R. S. Leighton, Water Resources Engineer, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the dam, Highland Ditch and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Highland Ditch

SW¼ SE¼ Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 9, bears S. 75°16'00" E., a distance of 1,650 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Truckee Meadows Water Authority
Source: Truckee River (Highland Ditch)
Manner of use: Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 1.733 c.f.s, but not to exceed 377.88 acre-feet as decreed
Period of use: As Decreed
Date of priority of appropriation: *January 29, 1865 (Claim 568) September 3, 1887 (Claim 568a)

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by a diversion dam from the Truckee River to the Highland Ditch; it is then conveyed to the Sierra Pacific Power Company's distribution system which distributes the water to the place of use located within the NE¼ NW¼, NW¼ NW¼, NW¼ NE¼, SW¼ NE¼ Section 4, T. 19N., R. 20E., MDB&M, where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

*This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Claims 568/568a, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claims 568/568a.

This certificate is amended to correct the rate of diversion and maximum duty of water allowed, and reflects the current owner of record as shown in the office of the State Engineer.

The certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.

Leighton, Water Resources Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River (Claim Nos. 568 and 568a) through dam, Highland Ditch and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., 1,650 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Water is diverted by a diversion dam from the Truckee River to the Highland Ditch; it is then conveyed to the Sierra Pacific Power Company's distribution system which distributes the water to the place of use located within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion and manner of use of a portion of water under Claim Nos. 568 and 568a, Truckee River. Final Decree, in Equity, Docket No. A-3, in the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada.

(Point of diversion of water is changed from the North Truckee Ditch to the Highland Ditch)

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
