CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. I. Cowles, secretary has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Trail Canyon Spring through a rock spout, pipeline and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 30 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Sec. 5, T. 30 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 33° 12' 28" E., 10,884 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 21, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a rock spout and is conveyed by 20' of 3/4" pipe to a trough 3' x 10' x 1.5' located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T. 30 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., (unsurveyed) where it is used to water cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
