

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settlemeyer, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, storage tank and troughs for stock watering purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 23 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Sec. 10, T. 23 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 15° W., 8,056.10 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Pete Elia, dba Smith Creek Livestock Company

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 10,000 sheep

Period of use, from October 20th to April 1st of each year following

Date of priority of appropriation January 5, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a storage tank thence conveyed to troughs where it is used to water sheep within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 3, T. 23 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
