CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. A. Bartholomae has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Birch Ranch Domestic Well) through well, pump, tank, pipelines and troughs for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the West 1/4 corner of Sec. 28, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 78° 56' W., 7,238 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Wm. A. Bartholomae
Post-office address: Walnut, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 9, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a storage tank; it is then conveyed by pipelines to service connections of two ranch buildings and to a watering trough all located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
