CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Itcaina Mizpah Well No. 1 through well, pump, tank and troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 30 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the corner common to Secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, T. 31 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 30' E., 39,370 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Name of appropriator Itcaina Livestock Company (a copartnership consisting of Earl Edgar, Lee Dearden, Jean Goyhenetche and H. Gordon Lathrop) Post-office address Elko, Nevada Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 10,000 sheep Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year Date of priority of appropriation February 16, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a storage tank and troughs located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29 and SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T. 30 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 10,000 sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
