CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John A. Modawell, Land Surveyor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Coyote Springs through pipe, tanks and pond for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 22 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 12 bears S. 33° E., 404 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 23, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of a pipeline to a storage tank thence by pipe to a watering trough and pond located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 22 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
