CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dorothy Towne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (cold water well) through well, pump, tank and pipelines for commercial (trailer courts) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 30° 55' 09" W., 2,394.47 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 9, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a pressure tank from where it is distributed to 50 trailer court units located within the W 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
