CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James P. Wirick has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from graveyard drain or slough (drainage water from Humboldt River) through dam, headgate and ditch for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 27 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 21 bears S. 54° 0' W., 2,750 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
