

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. D. Shields, Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 30 bears S. 55° 25' W., 1,356.5 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator California-Pacific Utilities Company, a California Corporation

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.75 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 19, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped into the distribution main grid which conveys it to the City of Winnemucca and adjacent areas located in Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30, T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
